Darkness to Light: In May of 2008, the South Carolina State Department of Education became the first in the nation to commit to a Statewide Adult Sexual Misconduct Prevention Initiative. South Carolina Superintendent of Education Jim Rex has implemented a statewide effort to train educators on preventing sexual exploitation of children, and help make schools safer by helping teachers prevent, recognize and react responsibly to signs of child sexual abuse. A Charleston-based non-profit group, *Darkness to Light*, will be sponsoring the program dedicated to preventing child sexual abuse through education and public awareness. The goal is to have all teachers in South Carolina trained by 2013.
